- 7) **Submit with this application the following:**
 - (a) A High School Transcript
 - (b) Three letters of recommendation, including:
 - One from a teacher, one from a past employer, and
 - One from a person who knows you well and can discuss your qualification for this scholarship.

Selected candidates will be required to participate in an oral interview conducted by Gold Country Rotary.

Proof of enrollment is required prior to distribution of funds.
